The Zootechnical Standards Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2018

Interpretation

- **2.**—(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(1) applies to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.
 - (2) In these Regulations—

"the Animal Breeding Regulation" means Regulation (EU) 2016/1012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2016 on zootechnical and genealogical conditions for the breeding, trade in and entry into the Union of purebred breeding animals, hybrid breeding pigs and the germinal products thereof and amending Regulation (EU) No 652/2014, Council Directives 89/608/EEC and 90/425/EEC and repealing certain acts in the area of animal breeding as amended from time to time(2);

"the Department" means the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs;

(3) Expressions used in the Animal Breeding Regulation have the same meaning in these Regulations as in that Regulation.
