**The Carcase Classification and Price

PART 5

ENFORCEMENT AND OFFENCES

Offences: [F1retained EU] pig provision

24.—(1) Any person who—

- (a) fails to comply with any requirement under a [F1retained EU] pig provision, or
- (b) contravenes any prohibition contained in a [F1retained EU] pig provision,

is guilty of an offence.

(2) But where an operator or the person responsible for the classification of pig carcasses draws up a record in compliance with the conditions referred to in regulation 16 (records instead of marking) no offence is committed by failure to comply with or contravening the Part 2 [F1retained EU] pig provisions.

(3) In this regulation, “Part 2 [F1retained EU] pig provision” means a provision which is specified in column 2 of Part 2 of Schedule 2.
