**The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2019**

Made - - - - - *10th May 2019*

Coming into operation - *3rd June 2019*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 3rd June 2019.

Amendment

2. The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015^(d) is amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following items—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 (“the Order”) by the addition to Schedule 2 of the items specified in Article 2 relating to Main Street, Ballynahinch, Grange Road, Bangor, Victoria Road, Carrickfergus and Elmfield Drive, Hazelburn Road and Swanston Crescent, Newtownabbey.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the roads.
