Citation and commencement

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 ("the Order") by the addition to Schedule 2 of the items specified in Article 2 relating to Main Street, Ballynahinch, Grange Road, Bangor, Victoria Road, Carrickfergus and Elmfield Drive, Hazelburn Road and Swanston Crescent, Newtownabbey.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the roads.
