Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Mental Capacity (Research) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2019.
- (2) In these Regulations "HSC Trust" has the same meaning as in the Mental Capacity Act (Northern Ireland) 2016.

Appropriate body for the purpose of research

2. An appropriate body is a person or body designated as an appropriate body by an HSC trust or a university.
