**The Eggs and Chicks and Poultrymeat  
(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2019**

*Made - - - - 29th October 2019*

*Coming into operation 19th November 2019*

The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs<sup>(1)</sup>, being designated<sup>(2)</sup> for the purpose of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(3)</sup> in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Union in exercise of the powers conferred under that section 2(2) of that Act, makes the following Regulations.

There has been open and transparent public consultation during the preparation of these Regulations as required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>(4)</sup> laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety.
