- **10.** The owner of a horse or, if different, the keeper who has primary responsibility for it must comply with [F1Article 66(1)] to ensure that a horse's passport accompanies the horse at all times except

 - (b) when the horse is accompanied by a smart card F3...; or
 - (c) when the horse is accompanied by a temporary document ^{F4}....
