The Regulation (EC) No 1370/2007 (Public Service Obligations in Transport) (Amendment) (EU Exit) (Northern Ireland) (Revocation) Regulations 2020

Made - - - - 17th December 2020 Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 1

The Department for Infrastructure(1) in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of, and paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 and paragraph 21 of Schedule 7 to, the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018(2), makes the following Regulations.

Citation commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Regulation (EC) No 1370/2007 (Public Service Obligations in Transport) (Amendment) (EU Exit) (Northern Ireland) (Revocation) Regulations 2020 and come into operation immediately before IP completion day.
- (2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) applies to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Regulation (EC) No 1370/2007 (Public Service Obligations in Transport) (Amendment) (EU Exit) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 2020(**d**) are revoked.
