The Regulation (EC) No 1370/2007 (Public Service Obligations in Transport) (Amendment) (EU Exit) (Northern Ireland) (Revocation) Regulations 2020

Made - - 17*th December* 2020

Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 1

The Department for Infrastructure(**a**) in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of, and paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 and paragraph 21 of Schedule 7 to, the European Union (Withdrawal) Act $2018(\mathbf{b})$, makes the following Regulations.

Citation commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Regulation (EC) No 1370/2007 (Public Service Obligations in Transport) (Amendment) (EU Exit) (Northern Ireland) (Revocation) Regulations 2020 and come into operation immediately before IP completion day.

(2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) applies to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Regulation (EC) No 1370/2007 (Public Service Obligations in Transport) (Amendment) (EU Exit) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 2020(**d**) are revoked. Sealed with the Official Seal of the Department for Infrastructure on 17th December 2020
