The Planning (Development Management) (Temporary Modifications) (Coronavirus) (Amendment No.2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021

Made - - - - 24th September 2021
Coming into operation 1st October 2021

The Department for Infrastructure makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 27(5) and 247(1) and (6) of the Planning Act (Northern Ireland) 2011(1) and now vested in it(2).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Planning (Development Management) (Temporary Modifications) (Coronavirus) (Amendment No.2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2021.

Amendment to the Planning (Development Management) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015

2.—(1) In the Planning (Development Management) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015(3), in paragraph (3) of regulation 5A (temporary relaxation of pre-application community consultation requirements during Coronavirus emergency period)(4) for "30th September 2021" substitute "31st March 2022".
