The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs(\mathbf{a}) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 127(1) of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(\mathbf{b}).

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- **1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Edible Crabs (Undersized) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and comes into operation on 8th January 2022.
- (2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) applies to this Order as it applies to an Act of the Assembly.

Amendment of the Edible Crabs (Undersized) Order (Northern Ireland) 2020

- **2.**—(1) The Edible Crabs (Undersized) Order (Northern Ireland) 2020(**d**) is amended in accordance with paragraph (2).
 - (2) In Article 3 for "140" substitute "150".
