SOCIAL SECURITY

The Social Security (Income and Capital Disregards) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021

> Made 16th December 2021 Coming into operation 5th January 2022

The Department for Communities(1) makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 122(1)(a) and (d), 129A(1), 131(1), 132(3) and (5), 132A(3) and 171(3) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992(2), Articles 6(5) and 14(1) and (4) of the Jobseekers (Northern Ireland) Order 1995(3), paragraph 8 of schedule 1 to the Social Security (Recovery of Benefits) (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(4), and now vested in it(5), sections 15(3) and (6) and 19(1) and (3) of the State Pension Credit Act (Northern Ireland) 2002(6), sections 4(2), 17(1) and (3) of the Welfare Reform Act (Northern Ireland) 2007(7) and Article 48(1) of, and paragraph 4(1) and (3) of Schedule 1 to, the Welfare Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 2015(8).

These powers are exercisable by the Department for Communities by virtue of Article 2 of the Welfare Reform (Northern Ireland) Order 2015 (Cessation of Transitory Provision) Order 2020 (S.I. 2020/927)
