**The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021 (Amendment
No. 21) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021**

Citation and commencement

7.—(1) At the beginning of Part 2 (Restrictions relating to premises etc.) insert—

“Premises and businesses required to close

2.—(1) Listed premises” and “listed businesses” means the premises and businesses listed in Schedule 1.

(2) A person responsible for listed premises or a listed business must close those premises or cease to operate that business.

(3) Where listed premises or a listed business form part of larger premises or a larger business, the person responsible for those larger premises or business complies with paragraph (1) by closing only the listed premises or listed business.” and

(2) after the new regulation 2 insert-

“Requirements on retail premises

3. A person responsible for a shop—

- (a) must carry out a risk assessment which complies with the requirements of regulation 9(5)(a)
- (b) must retain the risk assessment referred to in subparagraph (a) on the premises and make it available immediately for inspection by visitors to the premises or to a relevant officer on request; and
- (c) must take all reasonable measures to limit the risk of transmission of the coronavirus in accordance with regulation 9(5)(b).”
