# ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

The Parking Places, Loading Bays and Waiting Restrictions (Coleraine) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021

Made - - - - 25th March 2021

Coming into operation - 19th April 2021

The Department for Infrastructure(a)makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

One written objection has been received and subsequently withdrawn and one written representation has been received and duly considered.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places, Loading Bays and Waiting Restrictions (Coleraine) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 19th April 2021.

#### Amendments

- **2.**—(1) The Parking Places, Loading Bays and Waiting Restrictions (Coleraine) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011(**d**) is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) to (4).
  - (2) For Article 11 (lengths of road on which vehicles must not wait) substitute the following—
    - "11. Save as provided in Article 12, a person shall not cause or permit a vehicle to wait—
      - (a) at any time on the lengths of road specified in Part 1 or Part 2 of Schedule 2;

- (b) during the hours between 8.00 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. on the days Monday to Saturday inclusive on the lengths of road specified in Part 3 or Part 4 of Schedule 2; or
- (c) during the hours between 8.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on the days Monday to Friday inclusive on the length of road specified in Part 5 of Schedule 2."
- (3) For Article 12(2) substitute the following—
  - "(2) Nothing in Article 11 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on the carriageway of the lengths of road specified in Parts 1, 3 or 5 of Schedule 2 for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle."
- (4) After item 34 in Part 3 of Schedule 2 add the following items—

"35.	Mountsandel Road (east side) – from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Mount Street for a distance of 18 metres in a northerly direction.
36.	Mountsandel Road (north-east side) – from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Mount Street to a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with St. Patrick's Avenue.
37.	Mountsandel Road (north-east side) – from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with St. Patrick's Avenue for a distance of 68 metres in a south-easterly direction.
38.	Mountsandel Road (south-west side) – from a point 48 metres south-east of its junction with Beresford Place for a distance of 294 metres in a south-easterly direction."

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places, Loading Bays and Waiting Restrictions (Coleraine) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 ("the Order") by the addition of no waiting restrictions on lengths of Mountsandel Road, Coleraine (Article 2).

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indication the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
