PUBLIC SERVICE PENSIONS

**The Public Service (Civil Servants and Others) Pensions
(Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2022**

*Made - - - - 18th March 2022
Coming into operation in accordance with
regulation 1(2)*

The Department of Finance makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1) and (2)(a), 2 and 3(1), (2) and (3) of and Schedule 3 to the Public Service Pensions Act (Northern Ireland) 2014⁽¹⁾. (“the 2014 Act”).

In accordance with section 21(1) (2) of the 2014 Act, the Department of Finance has consulted such persons as appear to the Department of Finance to be likely to be affected by these Regulations.

The retrospective provisions contained in these Regulations do not appear to the Department of Finance to have significant adverse effects in relation to the pension payable to or in respect of members of the scheme established by The Public Service (Civil Servants and Others) Pensions Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014⁽³⁾, nor in any other way in relation to members of that scheme. Accordingly, the procedures set out in section 23 of the 2014 Act are not applicable in respect of these Regulations.
