**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymena)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022**

Made - - - - - *19th October 2022*

Coming into operation *10th November 2022*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymena) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022 and shall come into operation on 10th November 2022.

Amendments

2.—(1) Schedule 2 to the Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymena) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021^(d) is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) After item no. 102 in Part 1 add the following item—

“103. Springwell Street (north side) – from a point 100 metres east of its junction with Duke Street for a distance of 50 metres in an easterly direction.”

(3) After item no. 30 in Part 2 add the following item—

“31. Windsor Walk (north side) – from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Doury Road for a distance of 111 metres in an easterly direction.”

Revocations

3. Item nos. 87 and 88 of Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymena) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymena) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 (“the Order”) by the addition of a no waiting at any time (loading and unloading permitted) restriction on a length of Springwell Street, Ballymena and a no waiting at any time (loading and unloading not permitted) restriction on a length of Windsor Walk, Ballymena as specified in Article 2. This Order will also revoke and re-enact existing waiting restrictions on Springwell Street.

Vehicles are excepted from the restrictions in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and the Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the roads.
