**The Parking Places on Roads (Electric Vehicles) (Amendment
No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022**

Made - - - - - *24th October 2022*

Coming into operation - *15th November 2022*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1), (13) and (16) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for electric vehicles on the length of road specified in Article 2.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places on Roads (Electric Vehicles) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022 and shall come into operation on 15th November 2022.

Amendment to the Parking Places on Roads (Electric Vehicles) Order

2.—(1) The Parking Places on Roads (Electric Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012^(a) is amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In the Schedule add—

“18.	St. Patrick’s Street, Draperstown (north side) – from a point 30.1 metres south- west of its junction with Derrynoyd Road for a distance of 3 metres in a south-westerly direction.	All hours	All days	No limit	No limit”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends The Parking Places (Electric Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 by the addition to the Schedule of the item specified in Article 2.
