**The Education (Curriculum Minimum Content)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022**

Made - - - - *10th February 2022*

Coming into operation *10th March 2022*

The Department of Education⁽¹⁾ makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 7(2) and 43(5) of the Education (Northern Ireland) Order 2006⁽²⁾.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Education (Curriculum Minimum Content) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022 and comes into operation on 10th March 2022.

Amendment of the Education (Curriculum Minimum Content) Order (Northern Ireland) 2007

2.—(1) The Education (Curriculum Minimum Content) Order (Northern Ireland) 2007⁽³⁾ is amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In Part 5 of Schedule 2, in the Table headed “LEARNING FOR LIFE AND WORK: Personal Development”, in the Column entitled “Personal Health” after “Pupils should have opportunities to:” insert “Receive training in (i) cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR); and (ii) automatic external defibrillator (AED) awareness.”.
