## Notice relating to local producer's licence – sales on own premises

It is an offence to sell, or make available for purchase, intoxicating liquor in these premises which is not produced in these premises.

It is an offence to sell, or make available for purchase, intoxicating liquor for consumption in these premises (unless an authorisation under Article 52F is in force).

It is an offence to provide a sample\* of intoxicating liquor to any person which exceeds:

Beer - up to and including 6% ABV**	852 mls
Beer – above 6% ABV	568 mls
Cider – up to and including 6% ABV	852 mls
Cider – above 6% ABV	568 mls
Spirits	105 mls
Liqueur	210 mls

<sup>\*</sup>A sample of intoxicating liquor is an amount (whether in one serving or more) which does not exceed the amount of each type set out in the Table(a).

It is an offence to consume intoxicating liquor, purchased in these premises, in these premises or adjoining or nearby premises if owned by or under the control of the licence, or used with permission of the licence holder.
