**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The Waiting Restrictions (Saintfield) (Amendment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 2023**

*Made* - - - - *15th August 2023*

*Coming into operation* - *6th September 2023*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No objection or other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Waiting Restrictions (Saintfield) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2023 and shall come into operation on 6th September 2023.

**Amendments**

2.—(1) The Waiting Restrictions (Saintfield) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017<sup>(d)</sup> is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In Article 1(2) for the definitions of “postal packet” and “universal service provider” substitute—

“postal packet” has the same meaning as in section 65(1) of the Postal Services Act 2011<sup>(e)</sup>;  
and

“universal service provider” has the same meaning as in section 65(1) of the Postal Services Act 2011.

(3) In the Schedule after item 3 add the following item—

- “4. Listooder Road (west side) – from its junction with Old Grand Jury Road for a distance of 111 metres in a southerly and then westerly direction.”

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Waiting Restrictions (Saintfield) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 (“the Order”) by amending the definitions of postal packet and universal service provider and by the addition of a no waiting at any time restriction (loading and unloading permitted) on the length of road specified in Article 2. Vehicles are excepted from the restriction in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of this Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and the Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
