**The Police Service of Northern Ireland  
(Amendment) Regulations 2023**

*Made* - - - - *4th April 2023*

*Coming into operation* *28th April 2023*

The Department of Justice, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 25(1) and 26(1) of the Police (Northern Ireland) Act 1998(1), makes the following Regulations. Those powers are now vested in the Department(2).

In accordance with sections 25(8) and 26(6) of that Act the Department has consulted the Northern Ireland Policing Board and the Police Association for Northern Ireland before making these Regulations.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Service of Northern Ireland (Amendment) Regulations 2023 and shall come into operation on 28th April 2023.

**Amendment of the Police Service of Northern Ireland Regulations 2005**

2.—(1) The Police Service of Northern Ireland Regulations 2005(3) shall be amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In regulation 3(1) in paragraph (a) of the definition of “public holiday”, for 2023 only, after “first Monday in May” insert “, second Monday in May”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE
