**The Pensions (2005 Order) (Codes of Practice)
(Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024**

Made - - - - *13th June 2024*
Coming into operation *5th July 2024*

The Department for Communities⁽¹⁾ makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 87(1) of the Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 2005⁽²⁾.

The Pensions Regulator consents to the making of this Order as required by Article 87(2) of the Pensions (Northern Ireland) Order 2005.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensions (2005 Order) (Codes of Practice) (Revocation) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024 and shall come into operation on 5th July 2024.
