## CHAPTER 9

Amendments relating to students becoming eligible for student support in the course of an academic year

## Amendments to the 2009 Regulations

45. In regulation 57 (qualifying conditions for maintenance grants) (as amended by regulation 12 of these regulations), for paragraph (5)(1) substitute-
"(5) Where a protected category event which results in a student becoming an eligible student occurs-
(a) in the course of the first academic year of a course; and
(b) on or before the course start date,
the student may qualify for a maintenance grant in respect of the four quarters of that academic year.
(5A) Where-
(a) a course designation event which results in student's course becoming a designated course occurs in the course of an academic year; or
(b) an in-year qualifying event (other than a settled status event) which results in a student becoming an eligible student occurs in the course of an academic year, the student may qualify for a maintenance grant in respect of such quarters of the academic year as begin after the event in question occurs.".
