**Payment by Gas Undertakers to Ministry of Commerce  
N.I.**

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND,  
UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920,  
AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE ELECTRICITY AND GAS  
(EXPENSES) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, PRESCRIBING  
THE RATE OF PAYMENT TO THE SAID MINISTRY FOR THE  
YEAR 1924.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland by Section 7 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, as amended by Section 2 of the Electricity and Gas (Expenses) Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, the said Ministry hereby prescribes that :—

- (1) The rate of payment to the Ministry of Commerce for the year 1924 shall be three shillings for each million cubic feet of gas sold during the year 1923.
- (2) Such payments shall, on or before the 1st April, 1924, be made to the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland at 13 Wellington Place, Belfast, by any Gas Undertakers in Northern Ireland with respect to whom an Order under the said Act shall have been made, by cheque made payable to the "Secretary, Ministry of Commerce."
