The certificate of appointment to be furnished under Sub-section 4 of Section 92 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1924, and under Sub-section 5 of Section 29 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, to an Inspector appointed for the purposes of the said Acts, shall be in the form set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

3. The National Health Insurance and Unemployment Insurance (Inspectors' Certificates) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1922 (a), are hereby revoked.

- (a) To enter at all reasonable times any premises or place, other than a private dwelling-house not being a workshop, where he has reasonable grounds for supposing that any employed contributors or any employed persons are employed;
- (b) To make such examination and inquiry as may be necessary for ascertaining whether the provisions of the said Acts are complied with in any such premises or place;
- (c) To examine, either alone or in the presence of any other persons as he thinks fit, with respect to any matters under the Acts, every person whom he finds in any such premises or place, or, whom he has reasonable cause to believe to be or to have been an employed contributor or an employed person, and to require every such person to be so examined, and to sign a declaration of the truth of the matter in respect of which he is so examined.
- (d) To exercise such other powers as may be necessary for carrying the said Acts or any of them into effect.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by Sections 101 and 129 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1924 (14 & 15 Geo. 5. c. 38) the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland hereby makes the following Regulations :---

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Northern Ireland) (Requisition for Birth, &c., Certificates) Regulations, 1925.

2. The requisition to be made to entitle any person to obtain a certified copy of an entry in a register of births or in a register of marriages in Northern Ireland for the purposes of the National Health Insurance Act, 1924, shall be in the appropriate Form set forth in the Schedule to these Regulations.
