these words occur and "purchased by or to be vested in" for "purchased by" where those words occur.

- (b) There shall be added to sub-section (1) of Section 21 the words "or such instrument shall have endorsed thereon a map or plan del neating the land and shall be registered in the Registry of Deeds for Northern Ireland" and in sub-section (2) of the said Section the words "may be made subject to the said rights and equities" shall be substituted for the words "shall be made free from the said rights and equities."
- 4. This Order may be cited as the Land Trust (Adaptation of Labourers Acts) (Northern Ireland) Joint Order, 1925.

LAND PURCHASE. Issue of Land Certificates.

Made by the Ministry of Finance under the Land Purchase Acts as those Acts apply to Northern Ireland under the provisions of the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, and of any Order made by His Majesty in Council under the last mentioned Act.

The Ministry hereby rescinds Order L of the General Rules and Orders of the Irish Land Commission dated 16th March, 1897, which, as that Order applies to Northern Ireland, provides for

the delivery of land certificates by the Registering Authority to the Ministry and not to the purchaser.

This Rule shall take effect from and after this date.

LAND VALUES (REFEREE).

Made by the Reference Committee for Northern Ireland constituted under Section 33 of the Finance (1909-10) Act, 1910 (10 Edw. 7, c. 8), and the Referees and Arbitrators (Procedure) Act (Northern Ireland), 1922 (12 & 13 Geo. 5, c. 9).

1925. No. 153.

In pursuance of Section 33 of the Finance (1909-10) Act, 1910, and the Referees and Arbitrators (Procedure) Act, (Northern Ireland), 1922, the Reference Committee for Northern Ireland constituted thereunder hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. Every notice of appeal sent to the Ministry of Finance (Estate Duty Office) shall be accompanied by a deposit fee of £2 2 0 to be paid by the appellant.

2. In the event of the appeal being withdrawn before it has been decided by the Referee, the said deposit fee shall be forfeited.

3. If and when a decision on the appeal has been made by the Referee, there shall be repaid to the appellant the residue (if any) of the deposit fee after deducting therefrom such costs and expenses incurred by the Ministry of Finance as the Referee may direct to be paid by the appellant, but where no such costs and expenses are allowed, the deposit fee shall be repaid in full.

4. These Rules shall be read in conjunction with the Land Values (Referee) (Northern Ireland) Rules, 1922 (S. R. & O. 63 of 1922), and may be cited as the Land Values (Referee) (Northern

Ireland) Rules, 1925.
