

longer appropriate to his case, he shall thereupon be transferred to the appropriate scale and shall be placed thereon in accordance with Regulations 24 to 29 of these Regulations, provided that if the salary payable in accordance with such placing in the new scale be less than his existing salary he shall enter such new scale either at his existing salary or at the maximum of the new scale, whichever is the less ; and provided, further that a teacher to whom Section 23 (4) of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, applies may, should that Section so require, be retained on a higher scale of salary than that appropriate to his case under these Regulations.

“ 31. ‘ Existing salary ’ shall, for the purposes of the foregoing Regulation, be actual salary plus accrued increment (if any) at the date immediately prior to the date of transfer as aforesaid.”

3. The foregoing Regulations shall have and take effect as from the 1st of August, 1926.

Compensation of Teachers of Transferred Schools.

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, NORTHERN IRELAND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AND APPROVED BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, NORTHERN IRELAND.

1926. No. 101.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 99 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, the Ministry of Education for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as “ the Ministry ”) with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, Northern Ireland hereby makes the following regulations :

(1) Where, in the case of any transferred public elementary school in which at the date of the transfer thereof to the Education Authority school fees were charged to any pupils attending thereat and such fees or any portion thereof were at the said date payable to or received by any of the teachers therein as part of their emoluments, the Education Authority discontinues the charging of the said fees in such school and undertakes to pay to any said teacher so long as he shall continue to hold his appoint-

ment as at the date of transfer such annual sum by way of compensation for loss of the said school fees as the Ministry may approve, the Ministry shall refund to the Education Authority two-thirds of the net expenditure as hereinafter defined incurred in relation thereto by the Education Authority.

(2) For the purpose of these regulations,

(a) "School fees" shall mean fees paid by pupils of transferred public elementary schools for instruction given within the ordinary school hours.

(b) "Net expenditure" shall mean the sum (if any) remaining after deducting from the total amount of compensation as aforesaid paid in the area of each Education Committee or Regional Education Committee such balance of all the school fees received by the education authority from pupils of all transferred public elementary schools in each such area as may remain after paying out of such school fees any sums that may be payable thereout to any of the teachers in the said schools not in receipt of compensation as above-mentioned in Article (1) hereof.

(3) In case of doubt or dispute as to the meaning and effect of these regulations, the decision of the Ministry thereon shall be final.

(4) These regulations may be cited as the School Fees Compensation (Education Authorities) Regulations, 1926.
