EDUCATION

Regulations No. 2, 1927, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor :---

"(h) Only time spent in teaching classes approved by the Ministry for the purpose shall be taken into account in reckoning full-time service under this Regulation."

3. These Amending Regulations shall take and have effect as from 1st August, 1928, and shall thenceforth be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations as amended by the Regulations for Secondary Teachers (Northern Ireland), 1926, Amending Regulations Nos. 1 and 2, 1927, and No. 3, 1928.

REGULATIONS, DATED 30th OCTOBER, 1928, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, UNDER SECTIONS 65, 69 AND 77 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, AND LAID BEFORE 'PARLIAMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 99 OF THE ACT AFORESAID.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the "Regulations for Technical Teachers, Northern Ireland, 1926, Amending Regulations, No. 4, 1928."

2. Paragraph (1) of Regulation 53 of the Regulations for Technical Teachers, Northern Ireland, 1926 (hereinafter called the "Principal Regulations"), as amended by the Regulations for Technical Teachers, Northern Ireland, 1926, Amending Regulations, No. 3, 1927, is hereby amended as follows :---

After "Ministry" in line 5 of the said paragraph insert :

"or in other classes approved by the Ministry for the purpose of this Regulation."
