

Dogs (Ireland) Order of 1902, Amendment Order ; and the Importation of Dogs (Ireland) Order of 1902, Amendment Order, No. 2, shall in their application to Northern Ireland be read and have effect as if the provisions thereof, saving only the provisions of Article 2 (1) (a) of the Principal Order, applied not only to canine animals but also to cats and all other animals of the feline tribe, wild or domesticated.

2. This Order may be cited as the "Importation of Dogs (Ireland) Order of 1902, Amendment Order (Northern Ireland), 1928."

THE FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS AND POULTRY) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1928, DATED 25TH SEPTEMBER, 1928.

1928. No. 108.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, as amended and adapted by any subsequent enactments and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Importation of Animals and Poultry) Order (Northern Ireland), 1924, is hereby revoked.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the First day of November, 1928.

3. This Order may be cited as the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Importation of Animals and Poultry) Order (Northern Ireland), 1928.
