Licensing : Registration.

LICENSING REGISTRATION REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND),
1928:

1928. No. 27.

I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR RICHARD DAWSON BATES, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section six of the Intoxicating Liquor and Licensing Act (Northern Ireland), 1927, and of all other powers me thereunto enabling do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. When a court of quarter sessions grants or transfers or refuses to grant or transfer an on-licence the clerk of the crown and peace shall enter in his Court Record Book such particulars relative to the said licence as are hereinafter specified, and, before the expiration of one month from the date of the decision of the court, transmit a copy of such entry to the petty sessions clerk of the district in which are situate the premises in respect of which the application is made :—

- (1) The address of the premises.
- (2) The date of the grant, transfer or order of the court and description of licence.
- (3) The Christian name, Surname and place of abode of applicant.
- (4) The Christian name, Surname and place of abode of the owner of the premises.
- (5) In the case of a transfer, the name of person from whom transferred.
- (6) Any restrictions or conditions relating to certificate (*e.g.*, limitation of area covered by licence, conditions regarding structural alterations, etc.).
- (7) The Rule of Court and the name of Justice or Justices adjudicating.

2. When a court of quarter sessions confirms or reverses the refusal of a court of petty sessions to grant a certificate for the renewal of an on-licence or confirms, varies or discharges any order of a court of petty sessions relating to any licence, the clerk of the crown and peace shall enter in his Court Record Book a copy of the order of the court and in the manner prescribed by section twenty-four of the Petty Sessions (Ireland) Act, 1851, transmit a copy of such entry to the petty sessions clerk of the district in which are situate the premises in respect of which the order is made.

3. The " Register of Licences " provided for in section sixteen of the Licensing (Ireland) Act, 1874, shall be in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed, and every petty sessions clerk shall enter in such register under the appropriate headings such information as is transmitted to him by the clerk of the crown and peace under the foregoing regulations.

4. Every petty sessions clerk shall enter in the said " Register of Licences " under the appropriate headings particulars regarding all such licences within his district as are granted, transferred or renewed upon production of a certificate granted, by a court of Petty Sessions.

5. In these regulations the word " licence " includes a wholesale beer dealer's licence and all such retailers licences as are specified in heading C. in the First Schedule to the Finance (1909-10) Act, 1910, except a sweet off-licence.

6. These regulations may be cited as the Licensing Registration Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1928.

7. These regulations shall come into operation on the first day of April, 1928.
