REGULATIONS, DATED 1st NOVEMBER, 1927, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR, ACTING JOINTLY, UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1924 (14 & 15 GEO. 5, C. 38), AND THE WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1925 (15 & 16 GEO. 5, C. 23).

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1924, and the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations :----

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1927, and shall be read as one with the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1924 and 1925, and these Regulations and the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1924 and 1925 may be cited together as the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1924 to 1927.

2. Sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (α) of Article 6 of the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1925, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

REGULATIONS, DATED 2ND APRIL, 1928, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR, ACTING JOINTLY AND IN CON-JUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTIONS 13 (2) AND (4) AND 30 (1) OF THE WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1925 (15 AND 16 GEO. 5, c. 23).

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour, acting jointly and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, and in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by sub-sections (2) and (4) of Section 13 of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925 (15 and 16 Geo 5, c. 23) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations :--

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Voluntary Contributors) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1928, and shall be read as one with the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Voluntary Contributors) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1926 (a) hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Paragraph (1) of Article 2 of the principal Regulations shall be read and have effect and shall be deemed always to have had effect as if the following definitions were added at the end thereof :---

"' Period of grace' has the same meaning as it has in the National Health Insurance (Arrears) Regulations, 1924.

"' Contribution half year' means any period in respect of which contribution cards may be issued under any Regulations relating to the collection of contributions made under the Insurance Act, and for the time being in force."
