MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SUB-SECTION (6) OF SECTION THREE OF THE ACQUISITION OF LAND (ASSESSMENT OF COMPENSATION) ACT, 1919.

1928. No. 67.

1.—(1) These rules may be cited as the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Fees Rules (Northern Ireland), 1928.

(2) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression "the Act" shall mean the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act, 1919, and the expression "Arbitrator" shall mean the official arbitrator appointed by the Minister of Finance pursuant to section 1 of the Administrative Provisions Act (Northern Ireland), 1928.

(3) The fees prescribed by these rules shall be collected by means of stamps impressed on the reference for hearing or the Award, as the case may be.

2. On every reference for the hearing of any matter by the Arbitrator there shall be paid the fee of £1.

3. On every Award the following fees shall be charged in respect of proceedings before the Arbitrator, namely a fee calculated at the rate of £6 6s. in respect of each day spent by the Arbitrator in hearing any matter or claim referred to him, and at the rate of £1 5s. per hour or part of an hour in respect of each period shorter than one day. For the purposes of this rule—

- (a) A day shall be taken to be a working period of five hours ;
- (b) any time spent by the Arbitrator in viewing any land which is the subject-matter of the proceedings before him shall be treated as part of the hearing ;
- (c) the minimum fee shall be £6 6s.

4. The fees prescribed in Rule 3 of these rules shall be in addition to the Stamp Duty charged on Awards by the Stamp Act, 1891.

5. The Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Fees Rules (N.I.), 1927, are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to arbitration in respect of land authorised to be acquired by any local authority or any public authority as defined for the purposes of the Act, but without prejudice to the application of the said Rules to any proceedings in respect of which an official Arbitrator had been appointed prior to the 4th day of June, 1928.
