

and fourth provisos to paragraph (1) of the conditions for the receipt of Benefit to the condition therein specified shall be deemed to include a reference to the conditions contained in sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of this paragraph.

Provided that sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph shall not apply in the case of a person who is, or has at any time during the two years immediately preceding the date of the application for benefit been in receipt of a pension paid out of moneys provided by the Parliament of the United Kingdom in respect of a disability contracted during the late War, if he proves that the non-fulfilment in his case of the condition contained in the said sub-paragraph (a) was due to that disability.

Provided further that paragraph (2) of this clause shall apply in the case of an insured person who has not attained the age of eighteen years if the Board so direct in his case.

In the case of any person formerly engaged in war service, the undergoing of training for an insurable employment shall, where the cost of the training is defrayed out of funds administered by the Minister of Labour for Great Britain or by the Minister of Pensions, be treated for the purposes of sub-paragraph (c) of this paragraph as employment in insurable employment.

In the foregoing provisions, the expression " person formerly engaged in war service " has the same meaning as in the Unemployment Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1922.

### Insurance Year.

THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (INSURANCE YEAR) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1928, DATED JUNE 15TH, 1928, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT, 1920 (10 AND 11 GEO. 5, c. 30).

1928. No. 73.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Sections 35 and 47 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, as adapted to Northern Ireland by the Government of Ireland (Adaptation of Unemployment Insurance Acts) Order, 1922, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. The period commencing on the second day of July, 1928, (being the day next after the last day of the preceding Insurance Year) and ending on the seventh day of July, 1929, shall be an Insurance Year.
2. These Regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Year) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1928, and shall come into force on the date hereof.
