**Evening Elementary Schools.**

REGULATIONS, DATED 21ST JANUARY, 1929, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTIONS 75 AND 77 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AND LAID BEFORE BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 99 (2) OF THE ACT AFORESAID.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the "Evening Elementary School Regulations, 1928, Amending Regulations, No. 1, 1929."

2. Regulation 27 of the Evening Elementary Schools Regulations, 1928 (hereinafter called the "Principal Regulations") is hereby repealed and the following Regulation substituted therefor:—

"27. Except in the case of full-time teachers in Technical Schools who teach in Evening Elementary Schools as part of their ordinary duties, managers are required to pay from the funds at their disposal remuneration to the teachers at rates not less than—

5s. 6d. per hour for Men.

5s. 0d. per hour for Women."

3. These Amending Regulations shall henceforth take and have effect and shall be construed with and as forming part of the said Principal Regulations.
