

work by reason of some specific disease or bodily or mental disablement; and

- (b) that there was good cause for his failure to make the claim on that date,

that date shall for the purpose of determining the commencement of that period of unemployment be substituted for the date on which the insured contributor made application for benefit in the prescribed manner.

2. The Unemployment Insurance (Commencement of Periods) Regulations, (Northern Ireland), 1924, are hereby revoked, but such revocation shall not affect any right, privilege, obligation, or liability acquired, accrued, or incurred under those Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Commencement of Periods) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1929, and shall have effect from and including the 31st October, 1929.

THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (INSURANCE INDUSTRY SPECIAL SCHEME) (VARIATION AND AMENDMENT) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1929, DATED 21ST MAY, 1929, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT, 1920 (10 AND 11 GEO. 5, c. 30).

WHEREAS the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") by the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Industry Special Scheme) Orders (Northern Ireland), 1921 to 1928, approved for the purposes of Section 18 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, a Special Scheme for the Insurance Industry and varied and amended such Special Scheme, which Scheme as so varied and amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme."

And whereas application has been made to the Ministry for the further variation and amendment of the provisions of the Scheme.

Now therefore the Ministry by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the said Section 18, Sub-section (4) of Section 8 of the

Unemployment Insurance (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1924, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order :—

(1) The variations and amendments of the provisions of the Scheme contained in the Schedule to this Order shall have effect and be deemed to have had effect as from 19th April, 1929.

(2) This Order may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Industry Special Scheme) (Variation and Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1929, and this Order and the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Industry Special Scheme) Orders (Northern Ireland), 1921 to 1928, may be cited together as the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Industry Special Scheme) Orders (Northern Ireland), 1921, to 1929 and shall be construed as one.

SCHEDULE.

(1) Clause 13 Part II (Transitional Provisions) of the Benefit Table forming part of the Scheme shall have effect as though in paragraph (2) :—

- (b) the words "shall continue to be so treated throughout a period of three years" were substituted for the words "shall continue to be so treated throughout a period of two years."
