 accordance with the provisions of Section 5 of the Act.

The holder may employ any other person to assist him in the conduct of his
 business without any further licence being required, but the licence may not be
 transferred to any other person nor may it be altered or tampered with in any way.

Any breach of this Licence is punishable by a penalty not exceeding Five
 Pounds, and Forty Shillings for every day that the offence continues after
 conviction.

REGULATIONS, DATED 14TH AUGUST, 1929, AMENDING THE
 RESPECTIVE REGULATIONS, SHOWN IN THE SCHEDULE
 HERETO, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER
 SECTION 17 OF THE TRADE BOARDS ACT (NORTHERN
 IRELAND), 1923, (13 & 14 GEO. 5, C. 32), WITH RESPECT
 TO THE CONSTITUTION, PROCEEDINGS AND MEETINGS OF
 TRADE BOARDS.

The Ministry of Labour (in this Regulation referred to as "the
 Ministry") in pursuance of powers conferred by the Trade Boards
 Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, and of every other power the
 Ministry hereunto enabling hereby varies the respective Regula-
 tions specified in the Schedule hereto, governing the constitution,
 proceedings and meetings of the Trade Boards concerned, to the
 following extent and in the following way:—

The following Regulation and proviso (a) shall be substituted
 for Regulation No. 10 and proviso (a) of the respective Regulations
 specified in the Schedule:—

10. The term of office of a member of the Trade Board shall
 be for a period of not less than one year nor more than three
 years, as may be determined by the Ministry, provided that—

- (a) the term of office of the members of the Trade Board may, at the discretion of the Ministry, be extended for such longer period, not exceeding nine months, as it may decide but, subject to Regulations 7, 8 and 9 of the respective Regulations specified in the Schedule, the term of office of all the members of the Trade Board shall expire on the same date.

Commencement of Periods.

THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (COMMENCEMENT OF PERIODS) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1929, DATED 29TH OCTOBER, 1929, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT, 1920 (10 AND 11 GEO. 5. C. 30) AND THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (No. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1924 (14 AND 15 GEO. 5. C. 25).

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland by virtue of the powers conferred on it by paragraph 5 of Part I of the First Schedule to the Unemployment Insurance (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1924, and by Section 35 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. If in any case an insured contributor claiming benefit in respect of a period of unemployment proves—

- (a) that he was on a date earlier than that upon which he made application for benefit in the prescribed manner in all respects qualified to make the claim, or that he was on that date unemployed but incapacitated for
