Contribution by County or County Borough Council.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, IN PURSUANCE OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 (3) OF THE MALONE TRAINING SCHOOL ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926.

1929. No. 98.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 3 (3) of the Malone Training School Act (Northern Ireland), 1926, (16 & 17 Geo. V, Chapter 22) and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. The contribution payable by the Council of the County or County Borough in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the above-mentioned statute, towards the expenses of a youthful offender who has been sent to the Reformatory School pursuant to an Order shall, from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and until varied by any subsequent Order be at the rate of 12/6 per week during such time as such youthful offender is detained in the Reformatory School.

2. Payment of the contribution as aforesaid shall be in arrear, and shall be made half-yearly by the Council of the County or County Borough in respect of the half-years ending 31st March and 30th September, respectively, and shall be made not later, than two months from the date of the claim for payment.

3. The regulations made by the Ministry of Home Affairs and approved by the Ministry of Finance on the 4th day of December, 1928, are hereby revoked.
