## Adoption of Children: Duties of Registrars.

MADE BY THE REGISTRAR GENERAL UNDER THE BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION ACTS (IRELAND), 1863 TO 1880, as APPLIED FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE ADOPTION OF CHILDREN ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1929.

## 1930. No. 17.

The Registrar General for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the Births and Deaths Registration Acts (Ireland), 1863 to 1880, as applied for the purposes of the Adoption of Children Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, by sub-section (8) of section eleven of the last mentioned Act, and with the approbation of the Governor of Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Adoption of Children (Duties of Registrars, &c.) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1930, and shall come into operation on the first day of July, 1930.
- 2. The superintendent registrar or registrar having the custody of the register containing the entry of the birth of an adopted child shall, on being so directed by the Registrar General, write in the margin of the entry the word "Adopted," with his signature and official description; and the superintendent registrar, or registrar shall also if so directed, make a certified copy of the entry, including the marginal addition, and transmit such copy to the Registrar General.
- 3. A superintendent registrar or registrar shall include in any copy to be issued by him of a birth entry to which a marginal addition has been made pursuant to the preceding article a copy of such marginal addition.
