REGULATIONS DATED THE 22ND DECEMBER, 1930, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1924 to 1928.

No. 174. 1930.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1924 to 1928, hereby make the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Joint Committee) Regulations (Northern Ireland) (No. 2), 1930.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything in the First Schedule to the National Health Insurance (Joint Committee) Regulations, 1929(a), the power to make Regulations providing for the transition of persons from the National Health Insurance Act, 1924(b), and the National Health Insurance (Prolongation of Insurance) Act, 1921(c), to the said Act of 1924, as amended by any subsequent enactment, shall as regards Northern Ireland be exercised solely by the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, without prejudice, however, to the validity of any Regulations already made in pursuance of the Regulations first named in this Article.
