Restricted Areas for the purpose of Grants.

1930. No. 29.

To the Councils of the several Rural Districts, the names of which are set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto :

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 4 of the Housing Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, that if the Ministry of Home Affairs is satisfied that in any particular area there is no urgent need for houses of the class in respect of which the building grant is payable, the said Ministry may, after consultation with the local authority or Council within whose district such area is situate, by Order declare that area (which shall be defined in the Order) to be a restricted area for the purpose of the building grant, and so long as such order remains in force no building grant shall be made by the said Ministry, or housing facilities be afforded by a local authority or council, to any person or body of persons in respect of a house constructed in such restricted area, unless the said Ministry is satisfied that the house is required and intended for continuous, as distinct from occasional, occupation :

And Whereas the Ministry of Home Affairs is satisfied that in the area described in the first column of the Schedule hereto there is no urgent need of houses of the class in respect of which the said building grant is payable :

Now, therefore, the Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 4 of the Housing Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, after consultation with the Councils of the Rural Districts mentioned in the second column of the Schedule hereto (being the Councils of the several Rural Districts within whose respective districts the area described in the first column of the said Schedule is situate), by this Order declares that the area described in the first column of the said Schedule shall be a restricted area for the purpose of the building grant as defined by Section 8 of the said Act, until the said Ministry shall otherwise determine.
