## Transfer of Powers to Ministry of Finance.

APPOINTED DAY FOR TRANSFER OF CERTAIN POWERS AND DUTIES TO THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER PART I OF THE DRAINAGE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1929.

1930. No. 38.

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (1) of section one of the Drainage Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, that the Ministry of Finance shall, subject to the provisions of the said Act, be the drainage authority for reducing flooding on Lough Neagh and the River Bann in accordance with certain recommendations mentioned in the said sub-section, and that the provisions of paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) of the said sub-section shall have effect as from such day or days as may be respectively appointed by the said Ministry for the purpose of each such provision:

Now, therefore, the said Ministry hereby appoints the first day of May, Nineteen hundred and thirty, as the day for the purposes of the said provisions, except provisions with respect to the Lough Neagh Drainage Trustees.
