

AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (MEAT REGULATION) RULES (NORTHERN IRELAND) No. 2, 1931, DATED 26TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1931.

1931. No. 139.

The Ministry of Agriculture by virtue and in exercise of the powers for this purpose vested in it by the Agricultural Produce (Meat Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, hereby makes the Rules following, that is to say:—

I. *Short Title.*

These Rules shall be known as the "Agricultural Produce (Meat Regulation) Rules (Northern Ireland), No. 2, 1931."

II. *Packing of Meat.*

Article V. General, of the Agricultural Produce (Meat Regulation) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1931, shall be read and have effect as if the following article were added thereto:—

"(4) All packages including wrappers, cases, containers, casks, crates or other receptacles containing meat to which the Act applies shall be—

- (1) thoroughly clean, and packages which have contained chloride of lime or other substance likely to contaminate the contents shall not be used;
- (2) of sufficient strength to stand handling in transit."

III. *Commencement.*

This Order shall come into operation as from the date hereof.
