WHEREAS by section 108 of the Companies Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, it was provided that sections 54 and 96 of that Act should come into operation on the passing thereof and that the other provisions thereof should come into operation on the appointed day and the appointed day should be such day as the Governor of Northern Ireland might by Order in Council appoint :

Now, therefore, I, James Albert Edward, Duke of Abercorn; Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, Knight of the Most Illustrious Order of Saint Patrick, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the said section 108 and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf do hereby appoint the 1st day of January, 1933, as the day upon which all the provisions of the Companies Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, which are not already in force, shall come into operation.
