BY THE GOVERNOR AND PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

ABERCORN.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section twenty-one of the Agricultural Produce (Meat Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland), 1930 (in this Order referred to as "the Act") that the Act shall come into operation on the appointed day and that the appointed day shall be such day as the Governor of Northern Ireland may by Order in Council appoint either generally or with reference to any particular provision of the Act, and that different days may be appointed for different purposes and for different provisions of the Act :

Now I, James Albert Edward, Duke of Abercorn, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, Knight of the Most Illustrious Order of Saint Patrick, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, do hereby order as follows :—

I appoint the first day of May, 1931, as the appointed day for all the provisions of the Act.
