THE SHEEP DIPPING (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER OF 1932, AMENDMENT ORDER No. 2, 1932, DATED 10TH JUNE, 1932.

1932. No. 61.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, as amended and adapted by any subsequent enactments and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

Amendment of the Sheep Dipping (Northern Ireland) Order of 1932.

- 1. The Sheep Dipping (Northern Ireland) Order of 1932 shall be amended by the addition to Article 8 thereof of the following clauses:—
  - (7) This Article shall not apply to sheep moved from land in the Irish Free State to land the property of the same owner in Northern Ireland provided that (a) such sheep have in the year of movement already been dealt with in accordance with the provisions of clauses (1), (2) and (3) of this Article and are accompanied by a certificate to that effect from the Sheep Dipping Inspector concerned and (b) the sheep are not kept with any other sheep that have not been similarly dealt with.
  - (8) If within the period 15th June to 15th November (both days inclusive) in any year sheep are brought from any place outside Northern Ireland for sale in Northern Ireland at any fair or market or at any sale either by auction or otherwise which is open to the public whether held in a public place or not the person selling such sheep at such fair, market or sale shall inform the purchaser that the sheep have been brought from outside Northern Ireland and if such sheep are sold at a sale yard or auction mart the owner of the sale yard or auction mart or the auctioneer shall at the time of sale inform the purchaser that the sheep have been brought from outside Northern Ireland.

## Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the date hereof.

## Short Title.

- 3. This Order may be cited as The Sheep Dipping (Northern Ireland) Order of 1932, Amendment Order No. 2, 1932.
