BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN TRELAND.

ABERCORN.

Whereas it is provided by section one of the Administrative Provisions Act (Northern Ireland), 1933, that, as from such day as the Governor of Northern Ireland may by Order in the Privy Council of Northern Ireland appoint, the public service in connection with the Ordnance Survey in Northern Ireland shall be transferred from the Ministry of Agriculture to the Ministry of Finance, and the last-mentioned Ministry shall be the department of the Government of Northern Ireland for the administration of that service:

Now I, James Albert Edward, Duke of Abercorn, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, Knight of the Most Illustrious Order of Saint Patrick, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, do hereby order as follows:—

The fifteenth day of December, 1933, is hereby fixed to be the appointed day for the purposes of section one of the said Act.
