

(d) to report to the Ministry from time to time as to the conduct and progress of the students and to recommend to the Ministry such disciplinary or other action as may be necessary in individual cases, should the student fail to comply with all reasonable requirements of the Committee.

4. The Ministry may, on the recommendation of the Committee, appoint such part-time or whole-time officers (including teachers) or servants as the Ministry may consider necessary and all such officers and servants shall during the currency of their engagement, which may be terminated at any time by the Ministry, act under the direction and supervision of the Committee.

5. Grants shall be made to the Committee by the Ministry from time to time, as may be necessary, at an annual rate in respect of each student who is the holder of a King's Scholarship, the rate being fixed by the Ministry with the approval of the Ministry of Finance.

6. The Committee shall charge such fees to students as may be fixed by the Ministry.

7. The Committee, from the funds at its disposal, shall defray the salaries, wages and other allowances of all whole-time and part-time officers and servants employed in the College, hostels, gardens and grounds and all expenditure incurred in connection with the supervision, instruction, board and lodging of the students, and maintenance and upkeep of the College, hostel, and demonstration school buildings, furniture and equipment, and of the gardens and grounds, or for such other purposes connected with the work of the College as may from time to time be found necessary or desirable. The Committee shall also, out of its income, set aside such annual sum as may be determined by the Ministry for the purpose of a Reserve Fund to meet capital expenditure and depreciation and the cost of major works of repair and maintenance.

8. The Committee shall keep accounts of all receipts and payments in such form as may be prescribed by the Ministry, and shall submit them to the Ministry for audit not later than 31st October in each year.

9. The Committee, on or before 1st December in each year, shall submit for the approval of the Ministry an estimate of its expenditure in the year ending on the ensuing 31st August under such headings as may be prescribed by the Ministry.

10. If any question arises as to the meaning, intention, or effects of any provision of this Schedule, that question shall be determined by the minister, whose decision shall be final.

Rules.

THE MARKETING OF EGGS RULES (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1933,
DATED 13TH FEBRUARY, 1933.

1933. No. 17.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in the exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Marketing of Eggs Acts (Northern Ireland) 1924 to 1931, and of any other power in that behalf enabling it hereby makes the following Rules, that is to say :—

I. *Short Title.*

These Rules may be cited as the Marketing of Eggs Rules (Northern Ireland), 1933.

II. *Amendment of the Marketing of Eggs Rules
(Northern Ireland), 1931.*

The Marketing of Eggs Rules (Northern Ireland) 1931, (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland No. 91 of 1931) shall be read as if, in Article IX (Testing) paragraph (1) and in Article XVI (Marking of Cases) paragraph (5) the words "the month of February" were substituted for the words "the months of February and March."

III. Commencement.

These Rules shall come into operation on the first day of March, 1933.

IV. *General.*

The Ministry may from time to time rescind, amend or vary these Rules, or any of them as the occasion may require.

Arbitrator's Award Regulations.

THE ELECTRICITY (ARBITRATOR'S AWARD) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1933, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1931.

1933. No. 78.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 33 of the Electricity (Supply) Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electricity (Arbitrator's Award) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1933.

2. An Arbitrator appointed under the provisions of section 33 of the Electricity (Supply) Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, to determine any matter shall complete and give notice in writing of the completion of his award to the Electricity Board for Northern Ireland and to the undertakers concerned within two calendar months from the date of the conclusion of the hearing of the case.
