

3. The time allowed for the examination in each subject must be two and a half hours.

4. The Authorities must appoint as examiners fully qualified, efficient and experienced teachers who may be engaged either in the school in which the examination is to be held or in some other school, provided that no teacher who is responsible for any part of the instruction of a group of students may act as examiner of those students.

5. The Ministry reserves the right to refuse to sanction the appointment of any particular examiner and to require a fresh appointment to be made.

6. In order to secure, as far as possible, a uniform standard of examination, instructions as to the method of conducting the examinations will be issued by the Ministry to each examiner.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE.

1. A candidate at the examination for the Advanced Art Certificate of the Ministry will be exempted from the condition requiring him to have previously been awarded or qualified for the award of the Elementary Art Certificate if he produces evidence to the Ministry showing that he has—

- (a) passed the examination in Drawing of the Board of Education, London, or
- (b) passed in all subjects of one group of the Third Year of the Course in Art in the Technical School Examinations of the Ministry, or
- (c) pursued such a course of study in a school or college of Art and passed such examinations during or at the end of the course as may be accepted for this purpose by the Ministry, or
- (d) gained such other qualifications as the Ministry may accept for this purpose.

#### Technological Scholarships.

REGULATIONS, DATED THE TWENTY-SEVENTH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1933, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, AND DULY LAID BEFORE PARLIAMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 TO 1931.

1933. No. 28.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the "Technological Scholarship Regulations, 1927, Amending Regulations, No. 1, 1933."

2. Regulation 5 of the Technological Scholarship Regulations, 1927, is amended by the substitution of "£110" for "£140" in Section (2) and by the addition of the following sub-section at the end of the same section :—

"(c) the Ministry may, on such conditions as it may think fit, make a grant not exceeding £30 to a scholar in Applied Science in the first year of tenure of the scholarship, towards the expense necessarily incurred by him in procuring instruments and apparatus for the purpose of his course of training."

3. These Amending Regulations shall take and have effect as from the 1st April, 1933, and shall be construed with and as forming part of the "Technological Scholarship Regulations, 1927"; provided, however, that Technological Scholarships awarded prior to that date shall continue to be subject to the Regulations under which they were awarded.

### Training of Teachers.

MINUTE MADE BY THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 1 (3) OF THE MINISTRIES OF NORTHERN IRELAND ACT, 1921 (N.I.), APPOINTING "THE STRANMILLIS TRAINING COLLEGE COMMITTEE."

WHEREAS a college for the training of teachers for service in public elementary schools in Northern Ireland, called the Stranmillis Training College, has been established and is maintained by the Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") at Stranmillis in the City of Belfast.

And whereas under subsection (3) of Section 1 of the Ministries of Northern Ireland Act, 1921 (N.I.), the Minister of Education may, if he thinks fit, by Minute to be laid before both Houses of Parliament, assign (subject to in the said subsection provided) any specified powers or duties of the Ministry to such officer, officers, or committee as he may appoint to exercise or perform the same under any designation having reference to such powers or duties.

Now I, the Right Honourable the Viscount Charlemont, Minister of Education, in exercise of the powers aforesaid, do by this Minute appoint a Committee constituted as set forth in the Schedule annexed hereto and having the designation of "The Stranmillis Training College Committee" for the purpose of managing the college aforesaid in accordance with and subject to the provisions in this Minute and in the Schedule thereto
