

THE MILK (EQUALISATION PAYMENTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934, DATED 21ST DECEMBER, 1934, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION NINE OF THE MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (24 AND 25 GEO. 5, CH. 16).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (1) of Section Nine of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say :—

1. The Milk (Equalisation Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1934, shall have effect as if for the First and Second Schedules thereto there were substituted, respectively, the First and Second Schedules hereto.

2. These Regulations may be cited as The Milk (Equalisation Payments) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1934, and shall come into force on the date hereof.
