Use of Motor Cars on Highways : Prescribed Routes (Warrenpoint).

THE ROAD VEHICLES (WARRENPOINT) REGULATIONS, 1934, DATED THE EIGHTH DAY OF AUGUST, 1934, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR NORTHERN IRELAND.

1934. No. 68.

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 8 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, that the Ministry of Home Affairs shall have power to make Regulations of a local nature with respect to the use of vehicles of any kind whatsoever on public highways :

Now, therefore, the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers vested in it as aforesaid hereby makes the following Regulations :---

1. A person driving or propelling a vehicle in the Town of Warrenpoint shall not proceed in the direction of Church Street from the Newry Road except by Meeting Street and Charlotte Street.

2. A person driving or propelling a vehicle in the Town of Warrenpoint shall not on approaching the Square from Church Street proceed in the direction of Newry Road except by the Square and Newry Street.

3. A person driving or propelling a vehicle in the Town of Warrenpoint shall not proceed :---

- (a) through the Square or along Newry Street except in the direction of Newry Road;
- (b) along Meeting Street or Charlotte Street except in the direction of Church Street.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Vehicles (Warrenpoint) Regulations, 1934.
